1.	Introduction to meeting The Chair, Councillor Ernie Brown welcomed all to the meeting and informed members the current youth provision agreement between SGPC and CYN will end on 31 st March 2021. The agreement is a complex one, which includes £10,000 funding from Southern Brooks, contracted for CYN to supply the provision of one night agreement ending 31 st March 2022. Southern Brooks, CYN and FACE have all been invited by Council to tender for the provision for one year.	ACTIONS
2.	To agree on Youth Provision agreement from 1st April 2021 – 31st March 2022 Following discussion Councillor Mike Brown proposed to not continue with the current agreement between SGPC and CYN ending 31 st March 2021. With so much uncertainty at the moment surrounding Covid-19, the premises in the Parish and also loss of income over the past twelve months, Councillors feel the one youth session per week (funded by Southern Brooks) and the current LDD evening is sufficient. The Parish continues to support its younger residents with the BMX track improvements,	

	<p>recreational and play areas and keen to continue to work closely with you on youth provision over the next year involving these facilities.</p> <p>The Parish Council have agreed to fund the cost of the location to accommodate the one session per week from 1st April 2021.</p> <p>Proposal seconded by Councillor Pauline Reich, unanimously carried.</p> <p>Councillors asked the Parish Clerk to write to CYN and thanked them for the service provided over the past eight years.</p>
